WHY AN INITIATIVE FOR HEPATITIS C VIRUS?

Almost **250,000 Canadians are infected** with chronic Hepatitis C Virus (HCV) – but nearly half don't even know it.^{1,2} HCV is a major contributing factor to hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC), the main subtype of liver cancer. Because the disease is often asymptomatic, many patients with HCV remain undiagnosed.¹ The consequences of this are serious: 60-70% of those with HCV will develop chronic **liver disease**; up to 20% will develop **cirrhosis**; and 1-5% will die from **liver cancer** or cirrhosis.³

By enrolling and enabling the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle, you will have access to:



Search queries to screen your patient database for critical HCV risk factors like liver disease, prior HCV-RNA test, age based populations and injection drug use



HCV Best Practice Workflows that guide you through how to screen, diagnose and refer patients



Active tasks to alert you to any follow-up HCV testing needed for patients



Configured forms and order sets for every step of the workflow that are prepopulated to save you time (e.g., pre-populated lab requisition form, HCV Risk Assessment Form)



Reports displaying aggregated data on how you and your peers are using the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle across Canada, allowing you to view the progress of this national initiative

HOW DO I DOWNLOAD THE HCV CLINICAL TOOL BUNDLE INTO ACCURO EMR?

Because this is an optional program, you must first enroll. You will have to log out and then log back into AccuroEMR to install the download. You will receive a message in your inbox confirming successful download of the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle that includes important information and next steps.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO ENROLL?

By enrolling you agree to download the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle into Accuro. Because this initiative is a partnership with industry, it is not available in the broad Accuro releases. Also, when you enroll, you will be agreeing to participate in reporting to help validate the outcomes of this initiative. This is done only with your consent and with aggregated and anonymized data. You can choose to opt out of the reporting function and still retain access to the tool set by visiting the Quality Improvement Initiatives page for the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle and de-selecting the option for reporting.

HOW IS DATA PRIVACY MAINTAINED?

Data is aggregated and no identifiable provider or personal health information will be shared publicly.

WHY REPORT MY DATA?

The data will help identify what's working and what's not in order to ensure continuous optimization of the HCV Clinical Tool Bundle to best serve the needs of healthcare professionals and their patients. Reporting your data will provide critical quantitative information to better understand the value of the tool set in identifying HCV patients, improving patient outcomes and reducing the burden of HCV in Canada.

The HCV Clinical Tool Bundle will be available indefinitely within Accuro. You can opt-in or out at any time.
